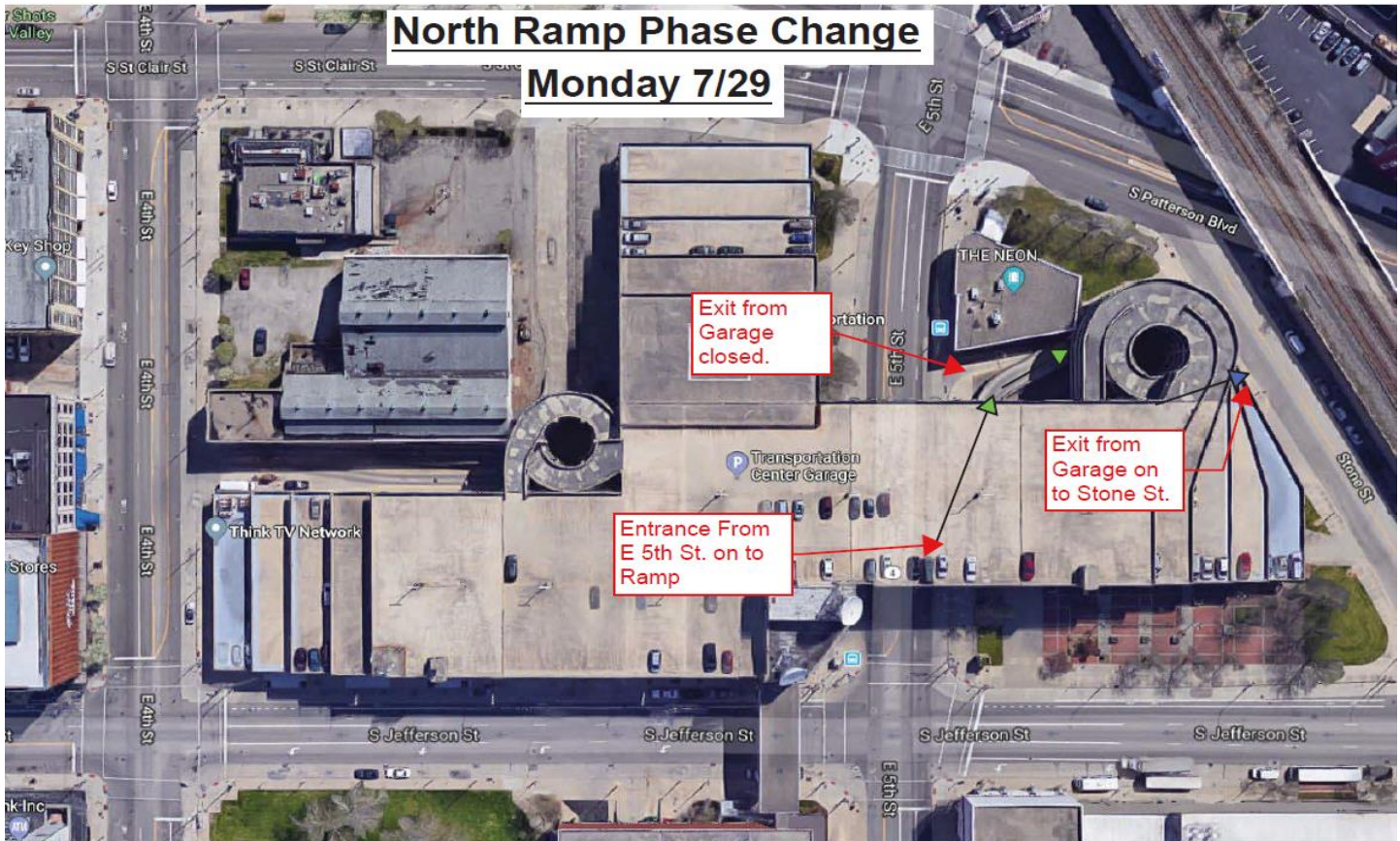


OREGON DISTRICT PARKING GARAGE RENOVATIONS & CHANGES

The Oregon District Garage is open, but currently under construction (formerly Transportation Center Garage).

The City of Dayton is investing in garage improvements including concrete parking deck restoration, waterproofing and lighting upgrades. Work began on Phase 1 on Oct. 1, 2018 and will continue through mid to late August, 2019.

PLEASE BE PATIENT AND BE PREPARED TO EXPECT DELAYS DURING HIGH VOLUME PERIODS.



CURRENT CHANGES EFFECTIVE JULY 30, 2019

1. THE TEMPORARY ENTRANCE ON JEFFERSON STREET IS NO LONGER IN USE.
2. **All vehicles will NOW enter at the E. Fifth Street ramp (main entrance).**
3. **Vehicles will exit to Stone Street (only). Signage is installed inside the Garage to direct drivers to the exit ramps on each level.**
4. Currently levels 2, 3 and 4 are open for parking.
5. Level 5 (rooftop) is slated to open on Friday August 2, 2019.
6. Level 1 is scheduled to open the week of August 5th.
7. When on any level that is full inside the garage parkers will not be permitted to go up to a higher level. Parkers will be required to exit the garage and re-enter to go up to a higher level where spaces are available.

CLEARANCE - 6'6"
(for Trucks, Vans, Campers, SUVs)

DO NOT USE THE OREGON DISTRICT GARAGE IF YOUR VEHICLE IS:

- A larger SUV with a wheelbase greater than 120 inches.
- A pickup truck with a wheelbase greater than 120 inches (extended, super cab & 4 door trucks).
- A full size van of any type.
- A vehicle with a clearance of 6'6" or higher.
- Any other type of vehicle with a wheelbase longer than 120 inches.

PARKING SAFETY TIPS

- **LOCK ALL WINDOWS AND DOORS.** Make sure all the windows and doors are locked when you are away from the vehicle, even for only a short period of time.
- **PROTECT YOUR VALUABLES.** Do not leave your property (including iPods, GPS's, electronics or purses) in plain view inside your vehicle, even when it is locked. Take your valuables with you or secure them in the glove compartment, center console or in the trunk.
- **DO NOT ...** leave firearms, identification, important papers and credit cards in your vehicle.
- **BE ON THE LOOKOUT ...** for anyone who is acting suspiciously or looks out of place (ie. looking in windows or checking parked vehicles). Make a note of the person's appearance, clothing description, and direction of travel. Call the police immediately at (937) 333-COPS (2677).
